

Repeat Dispensing Made Simple!

What is the repeat dispensing scheme?

It's simply a way to get your regular monthly medicine more easily.

What do I need to do to apply for this?

Contact the surgery and ask for a form to apply for repeat dispensing, complete it and hand it back.

What happens then?

- 1. The surgery sends your pharmacy 6 months worth of prescriptions.
- 2. When you need your next lot of medicine, phone your pharmacy to let them know you will be collecting it.
- 3. Your pharmacy will get your medicine ready for you to collect, or will deliver it to you if you ask them to.
- 4. When your pharmacy run out of your prescriptions they will tell you to order some more from the surgery.
- 5. You must then request another 6 months of prescriptions from the surgery in writing and the process starts again at number.1

In summary by being on the scheme you only need to order a new batch of prescriptions from the surgery when the pharmacy tells you to and in between just let the pharmacy know when to have your medicine ready to collect.
